August 1981 in Rheinfelden) ART DEALER – **be aware** 'In 1946, the Office of Strategic Services (OSS) Art Looting Intelligence Unit drew up a list of persons who were allegedly involved in "looted art" -trade. [6] This was published in 1998 by the World Jewish Congress (WJC). In addition to 72 other entries from Switzerland, Bernoulli also appears on this list. **But the list is based partly on speculation and should therefore be viewed with caution.** Bernoulli before 1939 (according to letters we obtained from the Kunsthalle Basel private Archive was a well respected Art Dealer with close ties to Galerie Flechtheim and Alexander Vömel. When he traded this painting is crucial to understand, if he is to be suspected of handling looted art.

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Risk Areas & Concerns

- We have no idea about the current condition of this painting. Condition Report Advised.
- How did the painting get from Galerie Simon /Leiris to Bernoulli in Basel? **However, this information is to a large extent checkable. With further analysis of Archives listed above.**
- When and where the painting was during the war years is not 100% clear at the moment.
- Why is Bernoulli mentioned in the Sotheby's Catalogue and not in the Catalogue Raisonne?
- Forensic Check of the painting advisable.
- Our current understanding of the painting would indicate that a Collector wishing to approach this painting for potential acquisition would require further clarification that the painting was not looted or could be subject to any future potential restitution claim.
- We would strongly advise not to progress or agree to a sales transaction on this artwork until further research has been concluded.
